#### १. प्रारम्भ

नेपालको प्रदेश न ६ र ७ का ग्रामीण क्षेत्रमा न्यायोचित, समतामूलक तथा दिगो रुपमा पानीको उपयोगको माध्यमवाट स्थानीय जनताहरुको जीवनस्तर सुधार तथा जीवीकोपार्जनका अवसरहरुको वृद्धि गर्ने लक्ष्यका साथ नेपाल सरकार र गणतन्त्र फिनल्याण्ड सरकार बीच सम्भौता भई आर्थिक वर्ष २०६३/०६४ देखि यस क्षेत्रका १० जिल्लाहरु (अछाम, बैतडी, बभाङ्ग,बाजुरा, डडेलधुरा, दार्चुला, डोटी, कैसाली, दैलेख र हुम्ला)मा सफलतापूर्वक निरन्तर रुपमा सञ्चालन भइरहेको ग्रामीण जलस्रोत व्यवस्थापन परियोजनाको(RVWRMP); आ.व. २०६३/०६४ देखि आ.व.२०६६/०६७ सम्म प्रथम चरण र आ.व. २०६७/०६८ देखि आ.व.२०७१/०७२ दोश्रो चरण सम्पन्न भईसकेको छ।

यस परियोजना अन्तर्गतका क्रियांकलापहरुको कार्यान्वयनको प्रभावकारिता मूल्यांकन गर्दा स्थानीय बासिन्दालाई प्रत्यक्ष रुपमा लाभ पुगेको देखिन आएकोले सोही कार्यक्रमलाई निरन्तरता दिई बढीभन्दा वढी जनसंख्यालाई सेवा पुऱ्याउने उद्देश्यले आगामी ४ वर्षका लागि परियोजनाको तेस्रो बरण कार्यान्वयनको द्विपक्षीय सम्भौता नेपाल सरकार र फिनल्याण्ड सरकारका मिति २०७२ मंसिर २४ गते (तद्अनुसार डिसेम्बर १०, २०१४) मा सम्पन्न भएको हो।

परियोजनाका कियाकलापहरु स्वीकृत परियोजना दस्तावेज तथा नेपाल सरकार र गणतन्त्र फिनल्याण्ड सरकार बीच सम्पन्न द्विपक्षीय सम्भौता अनुसार तयार भई परियोजनाको सुपरिवेक्षण समितिले स्वीकृत गरेका निर्देशिकाहरु अनुसरण गरि कार्यान्वयन गरिनेछ । नेपाल सरकार र फिनल्याण्ड सरकारको संयुक्त लगानी (अनुदान) रहेको यो परियोजना स्वीकृत परियोजना दस्तावेज, परियोजना कार्यान्वयन निर्देशिका तथा यो समभ्रदारी पत्रमा उल्लेख भएका प्रावधानहरु वमोजिम सञ्चालन गरिनेछ । स्थानीय पूर्वाधार विकास तथा कृषि सडक विभाग (यसपछि विभाग भिनएको) र चामुण्डा वृन्दाशैनी नगरपालिका (यसपछि नगरपालिका भिनएको),ले यो समभ्रदारीपत्रमा हस्ताक्षर गरी यस गाउँपालिकाको वाड नं ५ र ६ (तत्कालिन जम्मुकांध गाविस) को जलउपयोग गुरुयोजनामा उच्च प्राथमीकता कममा रहेका खानेपानी तथा सरसफाइ योजनाहरु र घरवारी व्यवस्थापन कार्यक्रम कार्यान्वनका लागि प्राप्त सहयोग कार्यान्वयनका मुख्यः सिद्धान्तहरूमा सहमति जनाएका छन्।

लगानीका सिद्धान्तहरु, कोष प्रवाह पद्धति तथा सो को प्रतिवेदन तथा कोष परिचालनमा विभिन्न पक्षको भूमिका र जिम्मेवारी ग्रामीण जलस्रोत व्यवस्थापन परियोजना, तेस्रो चरणको परियोजना दस्तावेज उल्लेख भएका प्रावधानहरु तथा परियोजना सुपरिवेक्षण समितिले निर्णय गरेवमोजिम हुनेछ ।

यस गाउँपालिका परियोजना सुपरिवेक्षण समितिको निर्णय वमोजिम सम्बन्धित आर्थिक तथा अन्य स्रोतहरुको दायित्व एकमुष्ठ रुपमा जिम्मा लिई व्यवस्थापन गर्न र कार्यान्वयन गर्न सहमत छ। यसका साथै जिल्ला समन्वय समितिवाट हस्तान्तरण भई आए वमोजिम अधिल्ला आर्थिक वर्षहरुमा आरम्भ भई क्रमागत रुपमा रहेका योजनाहरु सम्पन्न गर्ने तथा भुक्तानी गर्न बाँकी सेवा शुल्क वा उपभोक्ता समितिको किस्ताबन्दी रकम भुक्तानी गर्ने जिम्मेवारी

समेत बहन गर्न गाउँपालिका सहमत छ । यो समभ्रदारी पत्र परियोजना सुपरिवेक्षण समितिको मिति २०७४ असार २ गतेको निर्णय वमोजिम संम्पन्न गरिएको छ । यस समभ्रदारीको कार्यक्षेत्र चामुण्डा वृन्दाशैनी नगरपालिका को वाड नं. ५ र ६ (साविक जम्मुकांध गाविस) मा खानेपानी तथा सरसफाइ र घरवारी व्यवस्थापनका कियाकलापहरुमा गरिने सहयोगको लागि मात्र हुनेछ ।

### २. गाउँपालिकाको भूमिका र जिम्मेवारी

परियोजनाको गाउँपालिका स्तरको स्वीकृत वार्षिक कार्यक्रम,परियोजना कार्यान्वयन निर्देशिका वमोजिम कार्यान्वयन गर्ने जिम्मेवारी गाउँपालिकाको हुनेछ । परियोजनाको कार्यकारी निकाय (Executing Agency)को रुपमा गाउँपालिका निम्न वमोजिमको भूमिका निर्वाह गर्न सहमत छ,

### २.१ योजना छनौट तथा कार्यान्वयन

गाउँकार्यपालिकाले कार्यान्वयन सहयोगका लागि जलउपयोग गुरुयोजनामा प्राथमीकता तय भए वमोजिमका योजनाहरु छनौट गर्नेछ। यसरी छनौट भएका योजनाहरु प्राविधिक, सामाजिक र आर्थिक रुपमा सम्भाव्य देखिएका योजनाहरु मात्र स्थानीय तह योजना तथा बजेट तर्जुमा निर्देशिका बमोजिम वार्षिक कार्यक्रममा समावेस गरी परियोजनाको चरणवद्ध कार्यपद्धति अवलम्बन गरी कार्यान्वयन प्रकृया अगाडी बढाइनेछ।

#### २.२ आर्थिक व्यवस्थापन

१. परियोजनाको लक्ष हासिल गर्न तथा समुदायको मागलाई सम्बोधन गर्नको लागि गाउँकार्यपालिका जलउपयोग गुरुयोजना अनुसार समुदायले प्राथमिकता निर्धारण गरेका जलस्रोत विकास (खानेपानी, सरसफाई, साना सिंचाई, लघु जलविद्युत आदि) तथा जिविकोपार्जन योजनाहरु कार्यान्वयनको लागि आफ्नो तथा समुदायको तर्फवाट परियोजना सुपरिवेक्षण समितिवाट स्वीकृत निम्न वमोजिमको समपुरक कोष सहलगानी गर्न गराउन सहमत छ । लगानीको बाँडफाँड विस्तृत रुपमा परियोजना कार्यान्वयन निर्देशिकामा दिइएको छ ।

- गाउँपालिका क्षेत्रभित्र परियोजनालाई प्रभावकारी रुपमा कार्यान्वयन गर्नको लागि गाउँकार्यपालिकाले नेपाल सरकारका विद्यमान नीति, नियम, निर्देशिका, मार्गदर्शन र परियोजनाका सबै निर्देशिका तथा सुपरिवेक्षण समिति र निर्देशक समितिका निर्णयहरु पूर्ण रुपमा पालना गर्नेछ ।
- ३. गाउँकार्यपालिकाले परियोजना अन्तर्गत नेपाल र फिनल्याण्ड सरकारबाट प्राप्त अनुदान रकम र गाउँपालिकाको समेत लगानी रहेको "जलस्रोत विकास कोष" Water Resources Development Fund –WRDF को सञ्चालन, नियन्त्रण र नेपाल सरकारको नियमानुसार लेखापरिक्षण गराउनेछ ।
- ४ वार्षिक स्वीकृत कार्यक्रम वमोजिम योजनाहरुको वास्तिवक कार्यान्वयन गर्ने जिम्मेवारी उपभोक्ता समितिहरुको हुनेछ । योजना निर्माणको लागि आवश्यक पर्ने रकम गाउँकार्यपालिका कार्यालयले दर्ता भएका उपभोक्ता समितिहरुको खातामा किस्तावन्दी रुपमा नगदै निकासा गरिदिनेछ । जसको लागि गाउँकार्यपालिका, परियोजना र उपभोक्ता समितिको वीचमा अलग्गै त्रिपक्षिय सम्भौता गरिनेछ । परियोजना अन्तर्गत सञ्चालन हुने योजनाहरुको लागि आवश्यक पर्ने सम्पूर्ण खरिद कार्य परियोजनाको खरिद कार्यविधि वमोजिम उपभोक्ता समितिले मात्र गर्नेछन ।
- ४. गाउँकार्यपालिकाको कार्यालयले निर्धारित फाराम प्रयोग गरी मासिक रूपमा WRDF को खर्चको फाँटवारी परियोजना कार्यालयमा पठाउनेछ । यस्तो प्रतिवेदनमा नेपाल सरकार, फिनल्याण्ड सरकार तथा गाउँपालिका समेतको योगदान रकम उल्लेख भएको हुनेछ ।
- ६. वित्तिय अनुगमनको अंगको रुपमा परियोजना तथा जिससका आधिकारीक प्रतिनिधिलाई WRDF को अनुगमन गर्न तथा सम्बन्धित कागजातहरु अध्ययन तथा जाँच गर्ने अनुमती दिनेछ । यस्तो अनुगमनको प्रतिवेदन कार्यस्थलमा नै तयार गरी सम्बन्धित निकायमा यसको प्रती पठाइनेछ ।

### २.३ पारदर्शिता

जलस्रोत विकास कोषवाट हुने सम्पूर्ण आर्थिक कारोबारहरुको (उपभोक्ता समिति तथा सहयोगी संस्था, सेवा प्रदायकहरुलाई निकासा भएको सवै आर्थिक कारोबार) पारदर्शिता कायम राख्ने जिम्मेवारी गाउँकार्यपालिकाको हुनेछ । गाउँकार्यपालिकाले सबै खर्चहरु परियोजना दस्तावेज, परियोजना कार्यान्वयन निर्देशिका तथा यो समभ्रदारीपत्र वमोजिम भएको र जलस्रोत विकास सम्बन्धी योजना तथा कार्यक्रमहरुकोयोजना तर्जुमा, तयारी, कार्यान्वयन र निर्माण पश्चातको चरणका सवै खर्चहरुको सार्वजनिक परिक्षण चरणवद्ध कार्यपद्धितमा उल्लेख भए वमोजिम सम्पन्न भएको सुनिश्चित गर्नेछ । हरेक आर्थिक वर्षको अन्त्यमा गाउँकार्यपालिकाले जलस्रोत विकास कोषको आम्दानी तथा खर्चको विवरण सार्वजनीक गर्नेछ ।

- व्यक्तिहरुको सेवा शुल्क तथा अन्य सम्पूर्ण खर्चहरु वार्षिक कार्यक्रम अन्तर्गत जलस्रोत विकास कोषमा नेपाल सरकार र फिनल्याण्ड सरकारको तर्फवाट व्यवस्था गरिएको छ । गाउँपालिकामा आवश्यक पर्ने जनशक्ति सञ्चालित कार्यक्रमको परिमाण र प्रकृया अनुसार हुनेछ ।
- २. गाउँकार्य पालिका परियोजनाको कियाकलापहरु कार्यान्वयनको सिलसिलामा यस गाउँपालिकामा कार्यरत कुनै कर्मचारी अन्य गाउँपालिकामा समेत आँशिक रुपमा काम गर्नु आवश्यक भएमा यस्तो जनशक्ति लागत साभ्नेदारीको आधारमा एक भन्दा बढि गाउँपालिकामा परिचालन गर्न सहमत छ ।
- 3. गाउँकार्यपालिका उपलब्ध वित्तीय तथा मानवीय स्रोतको अधिकतम परिचालन गरी परियोजनाका कियाकलापहरुलाई प्रभावकारी रुपमा कार्यान्वयन गर्नको लागि गाउँपालिका क्षेत्रभित्र कार्यरत अन्तरराष्ट्रिय गैर सरकारी संस्था, दातृ निकाय, प्रदेश स्तरका विषयगत कार्यालयहरु सँग प्रभावकारी समन्वय तथा सहकार्य गर्न सहमत छ ।
- ४. यो समभ्तदारी आरम्भ भएको समयमा गत आर्थिक वर्षमा शुरु भई निर्माणाधिन अवस्थामा रहेका वा फरफारक गर्न बाँकी भएका योजनाहरु जिल्ला समन्वय समितिको सिफारिसमा गाउँकार्यपालिकाले जिम्मा लिइ योजना सम्पन्न गर्न तथा जिल्ला समन्वय समितिसँग भएका सम्भौता वमोजिम भुक्तानी गर्नुपर्ने वा लिनुपर्ने रकम फरफारक गर्न सहमत छ।
- ५. गाउँपालिका भित्र परियोजना अन्तर्गतका क्रियाकलापहरुलाई कार्यान्वयन गर्न सहयोगी संस्था एवं सहयोगी व्यक्तिको व्यवस्थापन निम्न वमोजिम गरिनेछ ।

### २.७ समन्वय तथा सहयोग

९ समन्वयातमक र एकीकृत जलस्रोत विकास कार्यक्रमको विकास र कार्यान्वयन यस क्षेत्रमा संलग्न सम्पूर्ण सरोकारवाला तथा निकायहरूको संयुक्त प्रयासबाट मात्र सम्भव छ भन्ने कुरामा सबैको सर्वसम्मित छ, अतः नेपालको संविधान तथा स्थानीय शासन ऐन, २०७४ तथा सम्बन्धित नियमावली द्वारा गाउँपालिकालाई प्रदत्त अधिकारको उपयोग गरी यी सम्पूर्ण सरोकारवालाहरू र निकायहरूलाई एउटै छातामुनि ल्याउन गाउँपालिकाले समन्वयकारी भूमिकाको निर्वाह गर्नेछ भने स्थानीय तथा प्रदेश तहमा उपलब्ध मानवीय, प्राकृतिक, सार्वजनिक र निजी क्षेत्रका स्रोतहरूको प्रभावकारी उपयोग गर्नुपर्नेछ।

- २. यस समभ्यदारीपत्रमा हस्ताक्षर गर्ने दुवै पक्षहरू फिनल्याण्ड सरकारको तर्फवाट प्राप्त हुने स्रोतको प्रयोगको पूर्वशर्तहरुको वारेमा जानकार रही यसको सञ्चालनको लागि उपयुक्त संयन्त्र तयार गर्ने कुरामा समान बुभाई रहेको छ । यस अभिप्रायले गाउँपालिका क्षेत्रभित्र कार्यरत सम्बन्धित निकायहरुको जलस्रोत विकास तथा जीविकोपार्जन कार्यक्रमको समन्वय र कार्यान्वयनमा सहकार्यता र एकरुपताको विकास गर्न संलग्न सरोकारवालाहरू बीच आवश्यकता अनुसार एउटा बेग्लै समभ्यदारी पश्रमा हस्ताक्षर गरिनेछ ।

### २.८ सुशासन

यस समभादारी पत्र मार्फत गाउँकार्यपालिका एकिकृत जलस्रोत विकास तथा जीविकोपार्जन क्षेत्रमा निम्न वमोजिमका प्रमुख तत्वहरु कायम भएको सुनिश्चित गरी सुशासन कायम गर्न प्रतिवद्धता जाहेर गर्दछ ।

- २. गाउँपालिकाको भित्र कार्यान्वयन हुने सबै जलश्रोत योजनाहरु अनिवार्यरुमा जलउपयोग गुरुयोजनामा तोकिएको प्राथमीकता वमोजिम छनौट गरिनेछ । साथै निर्माण सम्पन्न भएका योजनाहरुको दीगो सञ्चालन तथा मर्मत सम्भारको लागि गाउँकार्यपालिकाले योजनाको सञ्चालन तथा मर्मत सम्भार व्यवस्थापन तथा पानी शुल्क लगायतका प्रावधानहरु समावेश भएको खानेपानी मर्मत सम्भार नीति तर्जुमा गरी लागू गर्नेछ ।

#### Decision made by 4th Supervisory Board Meeting of RVWRMP III

#### 1. Revision of the decisions of the 3rd SVB Meeting and its status of their implementation

The decisions made in 3rd Supervisory Board Meeting held on 7th February 2017 (Magh 25, 2073) have been found implemented satisfactorily. Approval of additional budget for the fiscal year 2073-074 need urgent attention. The Board complements the entire project team for the progress.

#### 2. Approval of Working Modality of the Project

As RVWRMP is a project fully embedded in the local government structure and adopting a decentralized working modality, the Board decides to revise its working modality - especially the working area, fund flow mechanism and institutional operational management starting from fiscal year 2074-075 to ensure uninterrupted activity for smooth implementation of the project; executing under local level. The Board approves the changing modality proposal presented in the meeting and distributed to the SVB participants (Annex 1) with the incorporation of comments received from the members. Key Changes in the modality will be as follows:

- a. Fund Flow Mechanism: The fund from both the governments will flow to local level on the basis of the annual work plan. To make the fund flow more dynamic and responsive to each the Project working local level capacity to utilize the funds, the Board instructs the Project to estimate required GoF fund releases in maximum six annual installments. The funds to the Local level would be released against the fund request received on first-come-first-served basis. This would ensure timely fund release to each requesting local level. This meeting recommends the Project to prepare a detailed concept note to MEA through the Embassy of Finland that describes the revised system in detail.
- b. Management Structure at Local Level: As the Local level will have executing power, a Rural Municipality level Project Management Committee (GPMC) will be established with the chairpersonship of the elected RME chief in each core-program Rural Municipalities. The members will be the Water Resources Advisor (WRA), RME Office engineering section chief, Agriculture section chief and other relevant section chiefs. The Member secretary will be the Executive Officer of the RMEE Office. RMPMCs are responsible for planning, administration and management of all the Project activities in the Gaopalika. The GPMC will meet at least once in a month to review the progress of Project activities in the Rural Municipalities and discuss other relevant matters. The Project will procure one NGO in each core-program RM with enough technical human resources to facilitate the Project activities in the field by the end of FY 2074-075. The NGOs working in RM/M must be registered with RM/M and their annual program must be endorsed by their Council.
- c. Working Local Level: Considering the project target in Phase III (with presumed EU funding), available resources and the capacity of local bodies and requirement of ownership of the project initiatives by local government, the board decides to concentrate project activities in following 27 "core-Program Local Level" and the Board instructs the project to phase out gradually from the 43 wards of 21 "Program Local Level" after completion of committed water supply and sanitation schemes.

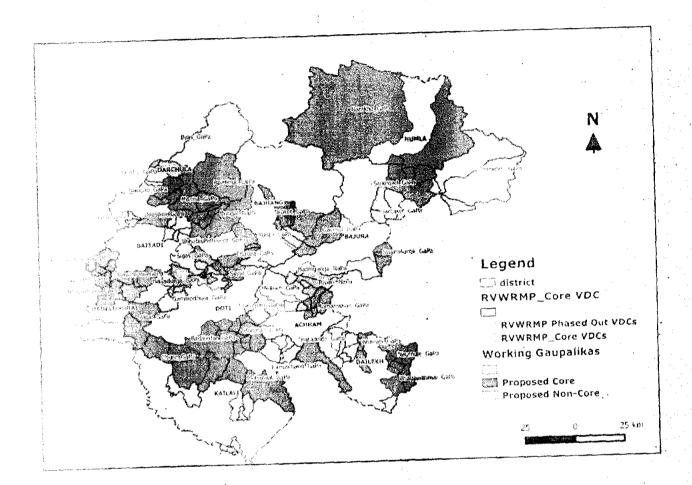

#### 1.1 Background

Rural Village Water Resources Management Project (RVWRMP) is supported by the Government of Nepart (GON) and the Government of Finland (GOF). It is continuation of financial and technical support that GOF has provided to the water sector in Nepal since 1989. Phase I (2006-2010), Phase II (2010-2016), is followed by the current Phase III (2016-2021).

According to the original plan, RVWRMP is working in the form of ten district-based sub-projects under the District Development Committees (DDCs). It's active in ten districts of the Far and Mid-Western Nepal. Achham, Baitadi, Bajhang, Bajura, Dadeldhura, Dailekh, Darchula, Doti, Humla, and Kaliali. Out of these Dailekh and Humla are located in Mid-Western Region (Province no 6 in the state restructuring) and the other districts in Far Western Region (Province no 7 in the state restructuring)

RVWRMP is a water resources management project which, in addition to water supply and sanitation, supports community-based irrigation, micro-hydro power, improved cooking stoves and water mills, number of environmental improvements as well as home gardens, sustainable livelihoods and institutional capacity building activities. The broad range of activities address poverty and as such, provide ample opportunities to develop different approaches promote good practices and trigger a range of ideas for improved well-being in these very remote villages.

User Committees (UC) plan, implement and later operate village level schemes. These schemes are based on the priorities as identified in each Water Use Master Plan (WUMP). UCs are supported by the Support Organizations/Persons (SO/SPs) and the Government of Nepal ageicnes in central and local levels.

61 VDCs of ten project districts were considered to be core working VDCs of the project during Phase III. Facilitation was planned for an additional 100 VDCs to prepare WUMPs, out of which 24 W:JMPs have already completed in the year 2016 and additional 31 WUMPs are under preparation at 2017.

As provisioned in the Constitution of Nepal, administrative restructuring is being enforced in the country, 382 VDCs/Municipalities of the existing project districts (including 6 VDCs of Kailali) are now converted into 86 Local Levels. Gaopalikas (Rural Municipalities) or Nagarpalikas (Municipalities) are formed by merging 2 to 8 existing VDCs. As RVWMRP is a project fully embedded in the local government structure and adopting a decentralized working modality, the restructuring will have significant impact. The local level development administration will come in to action starting from Nepali Fiscal year 2074/075 (16<sup>th</sup> July 2017).

In this context, the project working modality - especially the working area, fund flow mechanism and institutional operational management - needs to be revised to ensure uninterrupted and smooth implementation of the project. At the same time, the capacity building approach is redesigned in the to support the recently developed Gaopalikas, instead of District Coordination Committees (DCCs) (a temporary institution to substitute for the already down driven District Development Committees).

The kell of these introduced in the document are approved by document proposes the key. changes have been approved by the 4th Supervisory Board Meeting (16.06.2017) and to be applied from deginning of FY 2074/075. The changes will be incorporated in the Final Project Document as well as the Project Implementation Guidelines and any other project guidelines.

### 1.2 Institutional Management Structure

1. Local Level (in core Gaopalika only)

Since the Local level will have executing power, a Gaopalika level Project Management Committee (GPMC) will be established with the chairpersonship of the elected Gaopalika chief in each core Program Gaopalika. The members will be the Water Resources Advisor (WRA), Gaopalika engineering section chief, Agriculture section chief and other relevant section chiefs. The Member secretary will be the Executive Officer of the Gaopalika Executing Committee. Role and Responsibilities of stakehlders including GPMC is presented in following chapters of this document. GPMC will meet once a month to plan and review the project activities at Gaopalika level. DoLIDAR will sign MoU with Gaopalika for the execution of the project, Template of MoU with core Program Gaopalika is presented in Annex 1.

2. District Level

A conditoring and coordination committee (DPMC) will be established to establish proper encremation and monitoring of project activities. The committee will be chaired by the DCC chairperson, and be made up of chairpersons of Project working Gaopalikas, WRA and relevant line agencies' offices established at district level. The DPMC will meet twice a year on a semi-annual basis to review the progress of working Gaopalikas.

3. Project Management Committee (PMT)

Composition and ToR of the Project Management Team (PMT) established at project level in the chairpersonship of National Project Coordinator (NPC) will be unchaged.

4. The Project Steering Committee:

Composition and ToR of the Project Steering Committee will be decided later.

5. The Project Supervisory Board

The Project Supervisory Board at central level will have a similar ToR as the current Supervisory Board, with the chairpersonship of Secretary of MoFALD (or corresponding ministry), and having members from MoF, EoF, EU and DoLIDAR or corresponding department.

### Project Working Area

## 2.1 Core Program and Program Local Level

RVWMRP is working currently in 61 core VDCs. In addition to the 109 WUMPs prepared in earlier phases, now WUMPs are completed in 24 VDCs and 31 VDCs are under finalization. The Project is fully embedded with Local Government Structure and it fully supports and promotes decentralization and Local Self-Governance. Therefore, considering the restructuring of local bodies by the GoN, the Project needs to review its working area and approach. It is equally importance of ensure ownership by local government (Gaopalikas) of the project initiatives on planning implementation, reporting and monitoring of Water and Livelihood activities. At the same and the project needs to respect the needs and expectations of local residents of the axist at a which, where schemes have already been started, planned or commitment has a smaller. In this context, based on the meeting in PSU held on 19th March 2017, internal 1 in diantion meeting of 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017; the following strategy is proposed to support Gaopalikas in each of the working districts.

Considering the project target in Phase III (with presumed EU funding), available resources and the capacity of local bodies, the data has been analysed and it is proposed to consider core Program and Program Local Level among VDCs with a WUMP prepared. The project will continue its full menu of options to core Program Gaopalikas, and only water supply schemes and home garden activities will be implemented in Program Gaopalika/municipality wards (which currently falls in core VDCs) for a maximum two fiscal years.

The General Strategy of determining the Project working area is as follows:

1 full menu of options will be implemented in core-program local level; whereas the program local level will be phased out after completion of key schemes in the existing core FOC area. Maximum duration of the project in program local levels will be two fiscal rate [2.9] till the end of FY 2075/076). The Project will be working in 27 Core Program Gaopalikas and 43 wards of Program Gaopalika/Municipalities. Number of working Gaopalika and wards will be as follows; a more detailed list is provided in the Annex 2 and map of the proposed project area is presented in Annex 3.

WUMP of Core Program Gaopalikas will be prepared in 2018, by consolidating the existing WUMPs. Survey and analysis of data will be done for any new areas of core Program Gaopalikas (that didn't previously have a WUMP). No WUMP will be prepared in program local levels Gaopalikas in FV 2074/075. As suggested by the Third Supervisory Board, negotiations will be done with other Gaopalikas to prepare the WUMP with a cost-sharing approach. It will be started only in FY 2076/077. No support in scheme implementation for those non-project local level will be committed.

#### 2.2 Contributions

The minimum cash contribution from the Local Level, and both cash and kind from the users for a scneme, are required to demonstrate commitment and ownership. Feasibility will be assessed before starting any new schemes. Technical, social and financial feasibility of the proposed scheme will be assessed; and if the prioritized scheme is not found feasible due to any of the above reasons, the next scheme can be selected for support. The cash contribution from the Gaopalika/Municipality, and cash and kind contributions from users, will be of major importance and this cannot be over-emphasised.

#### Local Level (Cash) and Users (Cash and Kind) Contribution

The cash and kind contributions from the Local Level and users for investment costs of a scheme for different types of technologies are given in following table. The Local Level cash contribution is equal to total contribution of ex-VDCs and ex-DDCs.

### 3 HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

## 3.1 Technical Assistance (TA) Staff

Project Support Unit shall provide its support to DCCs and Gaopalikas from Dadeldhura as usual. No changes proposed. Among the current district TA teams will be stationed in the DCC premises and provide technical Support to the Gaopalikas from the current district headquarters. Considering the initial stage of development of the Gaopalikas and availability of technical human resources, the project may need to increase number of SWRTs/TFs to provide close technical support to core Program Gaopalikas in coming years after.

### 3.2 Project Coordination Office (PCO) Staffs

The Project Coordination Office will be stationed in Dadeldhura. Considering the EU funding and the volume of the project activities it would be useful to have a full time National Project Coordinator from GoN side in PCO office.

# 4 SUPPORT ORGANISATIONS/SUPPORT PERSONS (SO/SP):

BYWENCE held level activities are facilitated by Support Organizations or Supported Persons of the DCC. In the new context the supported mechanism shifts to Local Level from the DCC. Considering the number of core Program and Program Local Level, urgency of timely reporting of financial and physical progress and the need for proper mobilization of the field team in the Local Level, the following changes will be made.

- 1. At the peginning of Fiscal Year 2074-075, DCC will transfer all working SOs and SPs to respective local Level for uninterrupted progress of the Project. SO and SP fee is provisioned in the Local Level annual budget.
- 2. The Gaopaika (in support of the Project) shall gradually start recruitment of SOs for user core Program Gaopalika. Support for Program Local Level wards shall be provided by Lore program Gaopalika SOs. Considering the institutional enhancement of local NGOs and to maintain efficiency in monitoring and reporting and also considering limited number of TA staffs, the Support Person (SP) modality shall be discontinued in 5 districts (Bajura, Kailali, Bajhang, Dadeldhura and Doti) that are applying SP modality at oresent.
- 3. The Gaopalika shall appoint a Gaopalika Project Officer (GPO) in each core Program Gaopalika to mobilize the field staff team, and support the Gaopalika in project implementation, reporting and coordination. Cost of GPO shall be provisioned in annual work plan of Gaopalika under the GWRDF. The Project shall recruit the GPO and recommend Gaopalika for placement. GPO shall be mobilized under direct supervision of WRA of the Project.

recommend that the GEC applies an annual performance based contract. GPMC may decide to continue with existing working SO or select new one, considering its performance at Gaopalika level. Selection and placement of SO in all core Program Gaopalika shall be completed by the end of FY 2074-075. # 5.1 Gaopalika Executing Committee (GEC)

- Sign the MoU with DoLIDAR for the execution of the Project in the Gaopalika and execute signed MoU.
- Form the Gaopalika Project Management Committee (GPMC) and Monitoring Task
   Force (MTF) as agreed in MoU with the Project.
- Establish the Gaopalika Water Resources Development Fund (GWRDF) for funding in
  Water Resources management and Livelihood promotion related activities supported
  by RVWRMP. Request planned budget from GoN and GoF as scheduled in Annual Work

- Provide overall technical support to the UCs and SO staffs or SPs. Also monitor the performance of technical staffs assigned by SO.
- Establish Gaopalika level Management Information System (GMIS) and update it regularly.
- Formulate and approve Water Use Master Plan, Livelihood Improvement Plan,
   Operation and Maintenance Strategy/Plan, Total Sanitation Plan and other plans as required as medium term sector plan of the Gaopalika as provisioned in Local Governance Act 2074.
- Prepare Annual Budget and Action Plan of water supply and sanitation, irrigation, renewable energy, livelihood promotion, micro finance and capacity development activities as prioritized in sector plans based on the budget available from Government of Nepal, Government of Finland. Endorse and Implement the plan and policies from Gaopalika Councils.
- Contract SO or SPs recommended by the Project for the facilitation of project activities
  in the field in support of the Project contracting them on the basis of annual
  performance based contract.
- Appoint Gaopalika Project Officer (GPO) and mobilize in close coordination and recommendation of Water Resources Advisor (WRA) of the Project.
- Allocate and contribute matching fund (minimum 7% of the investment) for RVWRMP activities as provisioned in Annual Work Plan of respective year.
- Supervise and monitor planning and preparatory phase activities performed by SOs or SPs and ensure that Project Implementation Guidelines (PIG) and Step by step procedures are properly followed.
- Sign agreement with Users Committees (UCs) for scheme implementation and release investment fund in installment basis to the bank account of UCs.
- Support UCs in external material procurement as per the approved procurement manual and provide necessary assistance to implement scheme with standard quality and within agreed timeframe.
- Monitor the project activities in the field as provisioned in step by step manual

- The Lare and submit monthly, trimester and annual report (both physical and financial) and shomet to the Project, Provincial department and Federal ministries/departments.
- Proceeds assessary policy feedback to the Project, Steering Committee and Supervisory
- Formulate Gaopalika Level strategy for eradication of harmful Chhaupadi practices.
- Update database of the Gaopalika level.

# 5.2 Gaopalika Project Management Committee (GPMC):

Key role of the GPMC shall be to support Gaopalika to execute above mentioned role and responsibilities of the project. The GPMC shall meet in monthly basis to review the progress of the month and plan the activities for proceeding month. The GPMC shall provide all necessary support to the Gaopalika Executing Committee to implement the project activities in the Gaopalika.

### 9.3 Gacgafika Ward Committees:

Key role of Ward committee shall be as follows;

- Actively mobilize the Water Resources Management Sub-Committee and other CBOs for WUMP preparation process (social and technical assessment and need identification) ensuring participation of female and DAG community.
- Assess the water resources need of the ward and prioritize them to be includes in e WUMP.
- Assist UCs to implement identified water resources and livelihood activities.
- Provide necessary support to communities and UCs for implementation of livelihood and water resources development related schemes.
- Monitor, update and review the functionally status of water resources management related schemes/activities of the ward at least in 6 monthly basis and prepare or update ward level operation and maintenance (O&M) plan of the schemes.
- Monitor the water safety plan (WSP) and O&M plan of the schemes.

# Rural Village Water Resources Management Project (RVWRMP)

RVWRMP consists of a Project Support Unit (PSU) and a Project Coordination Office (PCO), and the key role of the Project will be to support the Gaopalika and other stakeholders to implement the project in the field. Role of the Project mentioned below is executed by Project Management Team (PMT). Generally the Project will not have direct program in the field. Key role of the Project shall be as follows:

- Provide technical and financial support for formulation of the Water Use Master Plan and other strategic mid and long term action plans of Gaopalika.
- Maingain effective coordination between DCC, Gaopalika, Provincial and national level authorities to ensure uniformity, transparency and strengthen the relationships among different stakeholders.
- Provide necessary support in monitoring of the activities. Provide sector specialists' support for monitoring of the activities and capacity building carried out at scheme, ward and Gaopalika level. Support in recruitment, mobilization and performance evaluation of Support Organizations and Support Persons.

- training programs, workshops and tours to strengthen the capacity of the Gaopalika to where was H and Livelihoods programs effectively and efficiently in a coordinated and decreasized manner, including work with women, the poor and excluded.
- Support in the orientation and training programs of Gaopalika level staffs. SOs and UCs for their capacity enhancement, in order to effectively implement Ward and community level project
- Support to establish the Gaopalika level Management Information System (GMIS).
- Provide specialized support and advice to the Gaopalika for formulation of policies, guidelines, strategies, plans and promotion of water, sanitation and hygiene and related monitoring and reporting at the Gaopalika level.

# 5.5 District Coordination Committee (DCC)

The Key Role of the DCC shall be to ensure proper coordination between local level, province level and federal level government agencies that includes:

- Ensure proper coordination among Gaopalikas and the Project.
- Monitor the project performance at Gaopalika level at least once a year.
- Participate in GWRDF monitoring together with the Project team.
- Facilitate to resolve the disputes arose at different level during implementation of the project.
- Monitor the implementation status of the strategic plans.

# 5.6 Support Organizations (SOs)

The Kev Role of Support Organizations (also refer to SPs for the FY 2074-075) shall be to facilitate project implementation at Gaopalika level, including capacity building at UC, Ward and Gaopalika level and reporting to the Project. In the scheme and other project activities implementation role of SOs shall

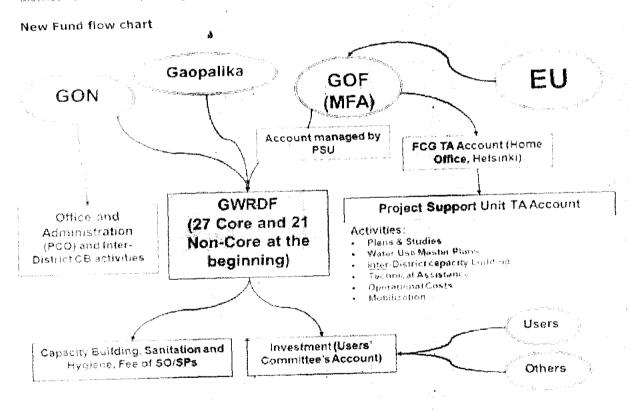

- Facilitate Preparatory phase activities as per the step by step manual, including feasibility study, UC formation, capacity building activities, survey and design of the schemes and formulation of Community Action Planning.
- Support UC for registration under the Water Resources Act.
- Support to communities to enhance livelihoods, to improve water supply and sanitation facilities and to generate funds.

- Monitor and review the functionality status of the schemes and support to prepare/update O&M plan of the schemes.

- Decide on matters which have implications for the Project's budget.

#### 6 FUND FLOW

## 6.1 Changes Proposed in Fund Flow and Management

The Gaopalika Water Resources Development Fund (GWRDF) (also refers to Municipality Water. Resources Development Fund (MWRDF) for Program Municipalities) is established in each Gaopalika/Municipality for investments and recurrent costs. There will not be any Fund at DCC level. The Governments of Nepal and Finland and the concerned Gaopalika contribute funds to the GWRDF annually as stipulated in the Annual Work Plan (AWP) of respective fiscal year. Funds under the GWRDF are for financing of all types of public construction related activities, service-fee and related cost of Support Organization and Support Persons, Administrative Cost and all type of capacity development activities in the Gaopalika (except central level capacity development and inter-district capacity development activities) as pervisously done through district Fund. No any changes proposed releasing fund to UCs from Gaopalika.



• The GON contribution for the investment of the Sub-projects will be channelled to the G/MWRDF (investment account) as per the budget allocated in the red book (budget) annually. The GoF/EU fund to the GWRDF will be deposited directly by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, Finland, upon the written request sent by the Gaopalika. The PSU facutates the fund flow through a separate account as before. Fund flow from GoF to

- regiment account will be done in 3 installments/year. PMT will decide on release
- Company of Inter-Gaopalika capacity building activities, the budget will be provisioned in one of the Gaopalika. The CB activities that needs participants from Gaopalikas of more than one district, the budget will be provisioned under Project Coordination Office or TA tunded CB plan as relevant.
- No changes proposed on UC and SO level payments. Both the UC and SO will receive funds on instalment basis, as indicated in the Agreements with Gaopalika. The UC bookkeeping and procurement is unchanged.
- All the payments from Gaopalika/Nagarpalika are made with the written recommendation of the Water Resources Advisor or assigned project representative.
   Regular monitoring of the expenditure of fund will be carried out by the WRA.
- A joint team represented by PSU, PCO and DCC monitor the G/MWRDF, visiting each district a minimum of twice a year.
- G/MWRDF is a part of Gaopalika account and all type of auditing of G/MWRDF will be done as per prevailing GON rules and regulations.
  - remaining of the Gaopalika/Nagarpalika level investment fund shall follow the GoN equivilent including:
  - 1. The Financial income expenditure statement will be made public by the Gaopalika/Municipality every month.
  - 2. The Trimester report shall be submitted to the Gaopalika executing committee meeting and forwarded to provincial and federal departments.
  - in addition, the income expenditure statement of the GWRDF should be submitted to the project on a monthly basis, in support of the GPO and WRA.
